## **PRO BONO OPPORTUNITIES WITH** KIDS IN NEED OF **DEFENSE (KIND)**

#### KIDS IN NEED OF DEFENSE

KIND (Kids in Need of Defense) has a tremendous challenge at the start of this year. Under one of our grants, we are required to place a certain number of cases each year. The year started in March of 2022 and given the slow return to work postpandemic, we have seen a huge decrease of interest by firms and attorneys to take on pro bono cases. We have around 30 cases that we still need to place with volunteers by March. The challenge is simply to match each child's case with a volunteer and make sure that the volunteers get KIND support in the long term, as they would always get with our office.

As background, we have placed several cases in 2022 but not enough to meet the high expectation by this funder. We have also taken on a similar number of cases that we have taken on direct representation through our team locally. However, we can really use the support of AILA to help us achieve our numbers. Even if we could get some of these cases placed with AILA attorneys willing to take on a case pro bono, that would be a huge achievement.
